ATCAA Early Head Start is a federally funded program for low-income families with children aged birth to 3 years and pregnant women. Head Start serves low-income families with children aged 3-5. Both programs provide a comprehensive early childhood education that enhances a child's cognitive, physical and, social-emotional growth and development. Our program fosters family engagement in all areas of a child's development and provides comprehensive resources to families in the areas of health, nutrition and community resources.

Family Advocates work at our Early Head Start and Head Start centers. Duties include: recruiting and enrolling families, assessing family needs and strengths and referring families to community resources. They maintain accurate service records for each family and input the data into a computer database. As a part of the center team, Family Advocates support all areas of family engagement.
